Product Description

The AQUASTEP screen is the latest development in the new generation of fine screens that have unique step shaped laminates. These stepped laminates enable the screen to capture and remove plastics and other solids from any water flow channels.

A set of stationary laminates alternates with a set of moving laminates, with the action lifting the screening up to the next stationary step. An upward transfer speed of approximately 1.5m/min is achieved while the screen is operating.

The Aquastep screen is available in 304 and 316 stainless steel and arrives fully assembled ready for installation in the water channel.

Over 25 years experience in designing screening equipment for Australian conditions ensures that the AQUASTEP step screen will be ideally suited for your application.





Design Advantages

- Maintenance is simple, as there are no submerged gears, chains or sprockets.
- An Electronic shear pin is provided for overtorque protection.
- Different step sizes are available to suit different screening applications.
- Slot width can be 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6mm to suit the application.
- Bottom grit guard to prevent jamming at the bottom step.
- Custom designed to suit the channel dimensions and easy to retrofit into existing screening channels.
- The screenings form a mat in front of the screen that provides a filtration size smaller than the slot size.
- Positive wiping of the screen discharge to reduce hanging over of screenings.
- Simple twin-cam design for low maintenance.


Design Features

- All Stainless Steel Construction.
- Stainless steel frame with cover to contain
- The laminates can be individually replaced.
- Thickness of each laminate is 3mm and very robust.
- Spacers are constructed of HDPE.
- The whole screen can be easily lifted up for servicing by unbolting the frame above the channel or pivot out of the channel for maintenance. (optional)
- Self-cleaning system which does not require spray water.
- Bottom and top HDPE guides.
